

Always be trustworthy and do your duty sincerely and never be lazy.




#### The Man and his Shoe Store

One day a man set up his shoe store named 'Shoe Shoppers'.


He was thinking if he had to pick some employees to help him in his store. He finally decided that he would do all the work so that he would save money and be rich.

The next morning he decided to select some employees to help him in his store. He selected three employees.




The next day the work was much easier. They all enjoyed and worked happily.
